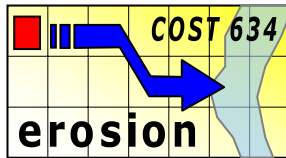

### Objectives

The objective of the meeting is to present well known but often underestimated off-site effects of soil erosion and sediment transport – like the impacts on water quality and water bodies, infrastructure, urban sites, etc.

The discussion should be targeted on the effects, but also on the methods to estimate, assess, predict or quantify sediment and nutrient transport and further effects such as the decrease in water quality. The economic and possible social effects can also be taken into account.

The methods and models reliability and applicability and input data availability for off-site soil erosion and sediment transport assessment should be presented. Also the techniques of sediment deposition and its quality estimation can be mentioned.

### Conference Focus Topics

- **sediment transport and deposition**
- **surface water pollution, eutrophication, muddy floods, organic C, pesticides, salinization**
- **surface runoff, infrastructure damage, property destruction**
